MEASURES TAKEN TO PREVENT THE COVID-19 OUTBREAK

Kenya Railways wishes to inform all Nairobi Commuter Rail (NCR) and Madaraka Express (ME) passengers that as per the Government circular OP/CAB/39/1A of March 13th, 2020; in order to comply with the directive and for the safety of our passengers, we have provided soap, water and sanitizers in all the stations and inside the trains. We also wish to assure passengers that our trains undergo thorough cleaning after every trip.

In light of the situation, we advise passengers to arrive at the station early enough to comply with the necessary sanitary procedures.

We encourage all passengers to observe all precautions as advised by the Health Ministry to curb spread of the virus. These include (but not limited to):

- Regularly wash your hands using soap and water or use a sanitizer.
- Avoid close contact with people who have flu-like symptoms.
- Cover your nose and mouth when coughing or sneezing.
- **Avoid travelling** if you have flu-like symptoms.
